Highlights for me....besides the great restaurants and good company were: The *Networking Table Topic session* sharing common concerns, ideas and best practices. I chose the table for "Hospitals with 100 Beds or Less" where we discussed volunteer

Risk Management Issues in the Volunteer Department was very interesting, but there was not enough time to answer all the questions! Hot questions asked had to do with, of course, background checks. Also discussed were security issues, workmen's comp, and patient safety.

There was even time to take in the "Mall of America"....no way could you see every store in the 4 hours we were there...dinner at Bubba Gumps was fun.

Lastly, congratulations to Jean Anton for a job well done, having served on the ASDVS 2005 Conference Planning Committee...it was a great conference! TONGUE FU! TIPS from Gwen Fujie (speaker at ASDVS National Convention)

1. When people complain, don't explain, take the AAAA train.
Agree ("You're right.") **Apologize** ("I'm sorry.") **Act** ("And I can ...")
Appreciate ("Thanks for ...")
2. Don't know what to say? Don't deny or defend. **Ask, "What do you mean?"**
3. In a disagreement? Replace the word "but" with the word "**and**" so you're connecting what's being said rather than canceling it.
4. Something gone wrong? Focus on the future with "**next time**" instead of punishing the past with "should." Be a coach, not a critic, so mistakes become lessons, not failures.
5. Are people arguing? Find solutions, not fault. Put your hand up and say, "**Let's not do this, instead let's ...**"
6. Feeling impatient? Fast-forward through your frustration by asking yourself, "**How would I feel ... ?**"
7. Circumstances not to your liking? "**We can't always choose or control what happens to us. We choose how to respond to it.**" - Victor Frankl
